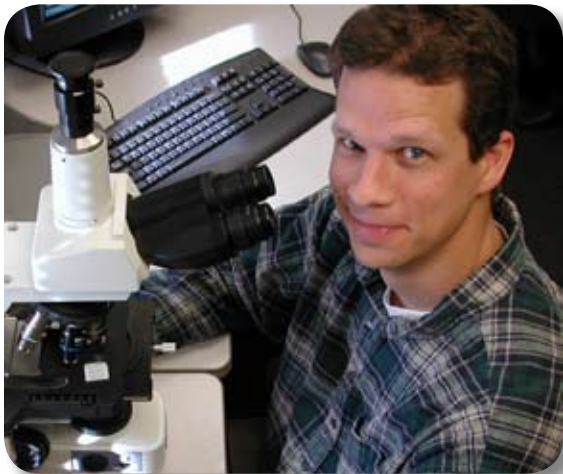




Robert A. Kurtzman, D.O., FCAP
