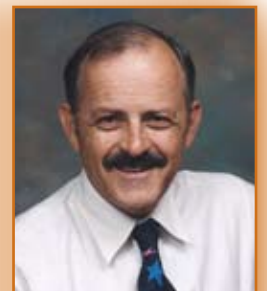
Craig L. Lastine, M.D.
