Dr. J. Dale Utt Appointed by Governor to Board of Medical Examiners

Grand Junction, CO - Colorado Governor, Bill Ritter, by executive order, has appointed Dr. J Dale Utt, family medicine physician to the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners (BME). Dr. Utt graduated from the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1978 and is Board Certified in Family Practice.

The State Board of Medical Examiners is part of the Colorado Division of Registrations (DORA). DORA is the largest division within the Department of Regulatory Agencies; the agencies share a common mission and set of goals: Public protection through effective licensure and enforcement.

DORA is responsible for the licensing boards and programs that have been created by the Colorado Legislature to ensure competence of licensees and to protect the public. The Division provides public protection through its regulatory bodies overseeing more than 47 different professions - from acupuncturists to veterinarians - throughout Colorado.
